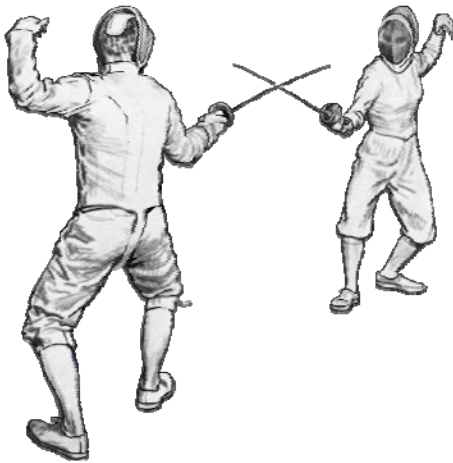


CLASSICAL FENCING WORKSHOP

About the Instructor:

Kim Moser began studying classical fencing at the Martinez Academy of Arms in 1989 where he spent several years gaining a thorough comprehension of French foil, later including French épée (dueling sword) and Italian dueling sabre in his studies. He also spent significant time studying French smallsword and Spanish rapier. While a senior student at the Martinez Academy, Mr. Moser was also an assistant instructor.

Mr. Moser has performed demonstrations of classical and historical fencing at several public events and on national television, and has also participated in numerous fencing tournaments across the country.

In February of 2000, Mr. Moser was certified by the Martinez Academy to teach French foil and épée. Since then he has founded the Palm Beach Classical Fencing school, which holds classes in West Palm Beach, Jupiter, and Tequesta, FL.
